Vote by Mail: <u>DEADLINE TO REQUEST A BALLOT IS 10/23!</u> (POST-MARKED by 10/23.)

If you meet the requirements to Vote-By-Mail and would like to avoid waiting in line during early voting or on election day, start the process to Vote-By-Mail. **Here's how:**

- **1. Get a Vote-By-Mail Application:** Download the VBM application from either the <u>Texas SoS website</u> or <u>the VZ County Clerk's website</u>. If you do not have internet access, contact the VZ County Clerk's Office and request they mail an application to you.
- **2.** Return the Vote-by-Mail Application to the Early Voting/ County Clerk's Office: Complete the VBM Application, **sign it**, and either mail it or hand deliver it to the VZ County Clerk's Office (they are located in the court house on the square).
- 3. The County Clerk's office will send the mail-in-ballot
- 4. Fill out the Vote-By-Mail Ballot
- **5.** Return the Vote-By-Mail Ballot to the Early Voting/ County Clerk's Office: Complete and confirm that you provided all necessary documentation.

Please read some great advice from the Texas Secretary of State.

Don't wait until Election Day to check your voter registration information. Verify that you are registered on the Texas Secretary of State Website. If there is a mismatch between where you live and the address for your voter registration, contact the VZ County Clerk's. Office, 903-567-7555. It takes about 30 days to get a new card, but if you don't get it, check the Texas SoS Website to see if they have updated your information. *NOTE: If anyone had problems with requesting or receiving their VBM ballot or encountered any issues while voting during the runoff, let us know.
